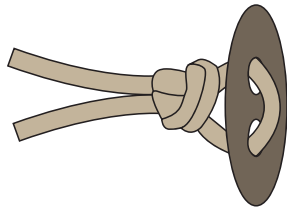
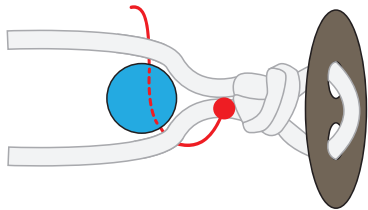


Bead and Leather Wrap Bracelet Tutorial

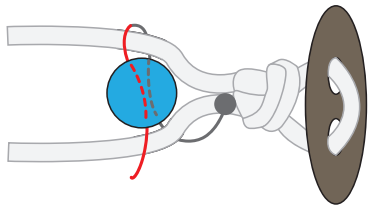


Step One: Cut desired leather cord length. Insert button, positioning it at the middle of the cord. Make a knot.

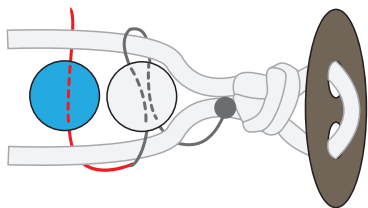


Step Two: Tie thread 2-3 times to bottom leather cord. Thread on bead and sandwich bead in between leather cords with needle and thread going behind the two leather cords.

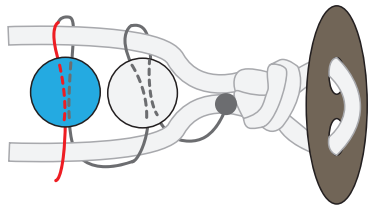
Tip: Glue knot with glue for maximum hold.



Step Three: Bring needle over the leather cord and thread back into bead and over bottom cord.

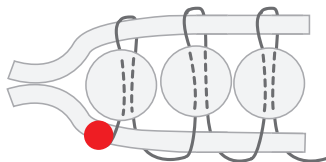


Step Four: Thread on next bead and sandwich bead in between leather cords with needle and thread going behind the two leather cords.

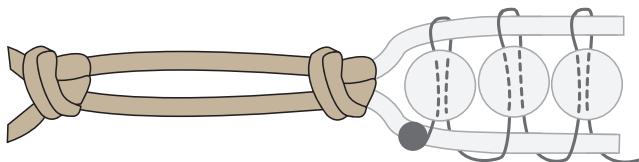


Step Five: Bring needle over the leather cord and thread back into bead and over bottom cord.

Step Six: Repeat until desired length.



Step Seven: When you have reached your desired bracelet length, tie 2-3 times to bottom cord. Glue knot and cut off excess thread.



Step Eight: Make a knot to tie leather cords. Make a second knot that is wide enough for your button to pass through.

Tip: If end knot does not securely hold, add a small dab of fast-drying glue to hold knot.
